Distribution of Points – 2026 Mixed Team Series

NCGA Mixed Team Series of the Year: For each 2026 Mixed Team Series event, a **point-level designation** will be assigned as shown in the table. Teams will earn points within their respective **flights** rather than across the entire field, as was done in previous years. All points earned will count toward a single Team of the Year list, so it does not matter whether a team competes in the A flight at one tournament and the B flight in another. The number of entries will determine the number of flights. We will aim to have 14 teams in each flight. The winner of each flight will earn 200 points toward the Team of the Year list. A “no show,” “no card,” or “disqualification” will result in the team receiving no points for that event.

A team will receive the full value of the points awarded to the Team of the Year points list. A team comprises of two players. A player may compete with a different partner during the season but will receive separate points with the different teammate. **The top-42 teams after the last Mixed Team Series tournament in October will receive an invitation to the Team Series Championship on November 4-5, 2026, at Poppy Hills.** If a player is on more than one team inside the top-42, he/she must choose which team he/she would like to compete on for the championship. The team that the player chooses not to play on will be ineligible for the championship and the next team on the list will be invited.

Ties: Teams that tie for a position will split points by adding and then averaging the positions affected, **EXCEPT** 1st place, which will be tie broken.

The top 5 teams on the points list after the last event in October will receive a PAID entry into the Mixed Team Series Championship in November.

Double Points for the Championship (2-day event): The 42 teams that qualify to the championship will receive double the points, because it’s a 2-day event and after the championship, the team with the most points will be the Team of the Year and will be presented trophies.
