Distribution of Points – 2026 Weekend Net Tour

NCGA WNT Player of the Year (Individual): Players will earn points **within the flights** and not over the field as we have done in the previous years. Your points will go to one Individual Player of the Year List, so it doesn't matter if you play in the A flight in one tournament and in the B flight in another. The top 112 players on the points list as of October 12th will receive an invitation to participate in the WNT Playoff on Saturday October 31 at Silverado. The top 40 players on the Player of the Year list after the playoff event will receive an invitation to the Tour Championship on November 14-15 at Poppy Hills GC.

The top 10 players on the points list after the playoff event will receive a PAID entry into the Tour Championship.

Two-day majors will be worth 2 times for the 36 holes played in each flight.

The number of entries determines how many flights we'll have. Normally for an individual full capacity of 112 players, we'll have 8 flights with 14 players in each flight. Each flight winner earning 200 points on the Player of the Year List.

NCGA WNT Team of the Year (Team Events): A team will receive the full value of the points awarded to the Team of the Year points list. A team comprises of two players. A player may compete with a different partner during the season but will receive separate points with the different teammate. **The top-20 teams after the last Team tournament will receive an invitation to the Team Series Championship on July 18-19 at Silverado.** If a player is on more than one team inside the top-20, he/she must choose which team he/she would like to compete on for the championship. The team that the player chooses not to play on will be ineligible for the championship and the next team on the list will be invited. No substitutions will be permitted for the championship. Furthermore, points are non-transferrable for players who compete on multiple teams during the season.

The top 5 teams on the Team of the Year points list at the conclusion of the regular season will receive a PAID entry into the WNT Team Championship

Ties: players/teams who tie for a position will split points by adding and then averaging the positions affected, **EXCEPT 1st** place, which will be tie-broken by the USGA method of scorecard playoff.

NCGA (Net) Championships: Any WNT player who qualifies for the NCGA Public Links Net Championship and/or the NCGA Net Amateur Championship will receive 50 points towards the WNT Player of the Year list whether or not they choose to participate in the championship proper. Any team who qualifies for the Associate Club Four-Ball Net and/or Four-Ball Net will receive 50 points toward the WNT Team of the Year list whether or not they choose to participate in the championship proper. To be eligible for individual points, a player must have competed in a WNT individual tournament prior to the individual championship in question. To be eligible for team points, both players on a team must have competed with one another in a WNT tournament prior to the team championship in question.

Minimum Tournament Requirements: To be eligible for the Weekend Net Tour Playoff event, a player must not only accumulate enough points, he/she must also have competed in at least 3 event days prior to the playoff event. (A two-day major is considered two event days.) To be eligible for the WNT Team Championship, a team must not only accumulate enough points, they must also have competed in at least 3 regular season team tournaments that allow postable scores (e.g. four-ball net, four-ball stableford, two-person aggregate).

Points Reset: Both the WNT Tour Championship and the WNT Team Series Championship will have the season points list reset for the championship.
