## Distribution of Points – 2026 Senior Series

**NCGA Senior Series Player of the Year (Individual):** For each 2026 Senior Series event, a point value will be assigned as outlined in the table. Players will earn points within their respective flights rather than across the entire field, as in previous years. Points will count toward either the Senior Individual Player of the Year standings or the Super Senior Player of the Year standings. It does not matter if you compete in the A flight in one event and the B flight in another. A no-show, no-card, or disqualification will result in zero points for that event. The two-day major will award double points for the 36 holes played within each flight. As of October 8, the top 20 players on each Senior Series Player of the Year list (Senior and Super Senior divisions) will receive an invitation to compete in the Senior Series Championship on Monday, November 9, at Castlewood Country Club (the Hill Course).

**The top 5 players on each points list (Senior and Super Senior) at the conclusion of the regular season will receive a PAID entry into the Senior Series Championship.**

*A player who begins the season (the season starts March 16) at age 64 and turns 65 during the season will remain in the senior division for the remainder of the season.*

**NCGA Senior Series Team of the Year (Team Events):** As with the individual events, team events will be assigned a point value as outlined in the table. Teams will earn points within their respective flights rather than across the entire field. Team competitions will feature two divisions: Senior Team of the Year and Super Senior Team of the Year. For teams comprised of one Senior and one Super Senior player, the team's flight assignment will be determined by the age of the younger player. All points earned will count toward the appropriate Team of the Year standings. It does not matter whether a team competes in the A flight at one event and the B flight in another. The number of entries will determine the number of flights, with a goal of 14 teams per flight. The winner of each flight will earn 200 points toward their division's Team of the Year standings. A no-show, no-card, or disqualification will result in zero points for that event.

A player may compete with different partners throughout the season; however, points earned with each partner will be tracked separately. Following the final team event in September, the top 10 teams on the Senior Team of the Year list and the top 10 teams on the Super Senior Team of the Year list will receive invitations to the Team Series Championship. If a player is a member of more than one team ranked in the top 10, he or she must choose which team to represent in the championship. The team not selected will become ineligible, and the next highest-ranked team on the list will receive an invitation.

No substitutions will be permitted for the championship. Furthermore, points are non-transferrable for players who compete on multiple teams during the season.

**The top 2 teams on the Senior Team of the Year points list and top 2 teams on the Super Senior Team of the Year points list at the conclusion of the regular season will receive a PAID entry into the Senior Series Team Championship at Castlewood CC (Valley Course) on Tuesday November 3rd.**

**Ties:** Players/Teams who tie for a position will split points by adding and then averaging the positions affected, **EXCEPT** 1<sup>st</sup> place, which will be tie-broken by the USGA method of scorecard playoff.

**NCGA (Net) Championships:** Any Senior Series player who qualifies and competes in the NCGA Senior Net Championship will receive 50 points toward the Senior Series Player of the Year list for their division whether or not they choose to participate in the championship proper. Any team who qualifies and competes in the Senior Four-Ball Net will receive 50 points toward the Senior Series Team of the Year list whether or not they choose to participate in the championship proper. To be eligible for individual points, a player must have competed in a Senior Series individual tournament prior to the Senior Net Championship. To be eligible for team points, both players on a team must have competed with one another in a Senior Series team tournament prior to the Senior Four-Ball Net Championship.

## **Distribution of Points – 2026 Senior Series**

**Minimum Tournament Requirements:** To be eligible for the Senior Series Championship, a player must not only accumulate enough points, he/she must also have competed in at least 3 individual Senior Series tournaments. To be eligible for the Senior Series Team Championship, a team must not only accumulate enough points, they must also have competed in at least 3 regular season team tournaments that allow postable scores (e.g. four-ball net, four-ball stableford, two-person aggregate).

**Points Reset:** Both the Senior Series Championship and the Senior Series Team Series Championship will have the season points list reset for the championship.
