A Season-Long Team Competition within the Women's One Day Series

REGISTER YOUR TEAM TODAY

What Is It?

The Women's Team League adds a season-long team competition to the Women's One Day Series. Players form teams of 4 from the same women's club and earn points at designated events throughout the season. The top three teams in each area will be recognized with year-end awards.

Who Can Play?

- Members of an NCGA Women's Club within the Area
- Current Handicap Index required
- Maximum Handicap Index: **40.4**
- All players must represent **one club and one team for the entire season**

Team Rules

- Teams consist of **4 players**
- Clubs may field **multiple teams**
- Players choose their own teammates
- Once registered, players **may not change teams**
- Only **two players from the same club may be paired together**
- Individual Stroke Play rules apply — **no advice between teammates**

Formats - Check each event for the format for that event.

Each event will specify the format: Stableford, Net. All events will score Two Best Balls of Four.

Maximum score: Net Double Bogey (Rule 21.2 / Max 10)

Points & Awards

- 1st place: 10 points*
- 2nd place: 9 points
- ...
- 10th place: 1 point
- Ties are not broken

NOTE: There must be 10 teams competing. If less than 10 teams are competing, the scale is as follows: 9 teams, then 1st place is 9, 2nd is 8, etc.; 8 teams, then 1st place is 8, 2nd is 7, etc.; 7 teams, then 1st place is 7, 2nd is 6, etc. . If there are only 3 teams competing, 1st place gets 3, 2nd gets 2, and 3rd gets 1 point).

Year-End Awards for the top three teams based on total points.

FAQ - What is the Women's Team League?

A season-long team competition that runs alongside the Women's One Day Series. You play your regular individual round, and your score also contributes to your team's result.

How do teams work?

- Teams are **4 players**
- You pick your own teammates
- Everyone on the team must be from the same NCGA women's club
- Clubs can have multiple teams

Can I change teams during the season?

No. Once you register with a team/club, you must stay with that team for the entire season.

Can my Team Substitute Players?

No. Players must remain the same for the entire season. A player may not be replaced except due to a situation where the player can no longer participate in any events. The circumstance would have to be discussed with and approved by the Staff-in-Charge. Once substituted, the original player may not be reinstated.

Do I have to play every event?

No. Teams earn points at each Team League event, but not all players need to play every event. Teams with more participation may have an advantage.

Are there any additional Team Rules?

- All players must have a **current handicap index** (maximum index 40.4)
- Players may represent **only one team** for the season
- Only **two players from the same club may be paired together in a foursome**
- Individual Stroke Play is conducted simultaneously; **no advice may be given between teammates**

What formats are used?

Formats vary by event and will be listed in the event details. All events will score two best balls of four.

How are points awarded?

- 1st Place Team – 10 points*
- 2nd Place Team – 9 points
- 3rd Place Team – 8 points
- ...
- 10th Place Team – 1 point

NOTE: There must be 10 teams competing. If less than 10 teams are competing, the scale is as follows: 9 teams, then 1st place is 9, 2nd is 8, etc.; 8 teams, then 1st place is 8, 2nd is 7, etc.; 7 teams, then 1st place is 7, 2nd is 6, etc. . If there are only 3 teams competing, 1st place gets 3, 2nd gets 2, and 3rd gets 1 point).

Ties are not broken—tied teams receive the same points.

Are there prizes? Yes! Year-end awards will be given to the **top three teams in each area** based on accumulated season points.
