PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read all of it carefully.

CLUB LOCATION: 7025 Oakmont Drive, Santa Rosa, CA 95409; 707-539-0415; www.oakmontgc.com

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day. All flights will play the West Course on both days. No players will play the East Course.

STARTING TIMES WEST COURSE (All Players will be playing the West Course): Saturday – Start times off tees 1 & 10, first tee time is 11 am. Sunday – 8 am Shotgun start. Registration will begin at 7 am for Sunday's final round.

REGISTRATION: All registration will be in the WEST Course pro shop area.

FOOD SERVICE: Saturday - A box lunch will be available to players at registration. Sunday – A BBQ lunch will be available to players only at the conclusion of play. Parents are asked to purchase their own food at the restaurant or snack bar.

RULES OF PLAY: The 2012-2013 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUND: Practice rounds are available to players at the very modest cost of \$7 per player. Please call the pro shop at the number above to reserve a time, and please identify yourself as a player in the tournament.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

LATE APPEARANCE: Players will not be paged for their tee time. It is the player's responsibility to be at their assigned tee on time and ready to play. "Ready to Play" means on the teeing ground with a club and ball in hand. If a player is late for his or her tee time but within five minutes late, the player will incur a 2 stroke penalty. If the player is late five minutes or more, the player is disqualified.

SCORE POSTING: The NCGA posts all scores from this tournament. Do not post your scores.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

PLAY-OFF: There will be a play-off for first place in each flight if necessary. Second and third place ties will be broken with a scorecard playoff.
