

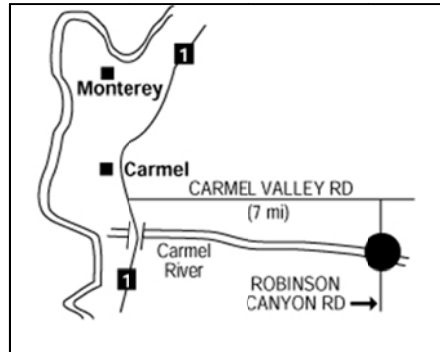

PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read carefully.

CLUB LOCATION:

FORMAT: 36 holes Mixed Chapman Stroke Play. In this format, two competitors play as partners as one side. Both players on a side tee off, then they switch balls. Player A plays Player B's drive, and vice-versa. Each player hits his or her second shot. They then select the better of the second shots, and from that point until the ball is holed they play only one ball in an alternate shot format. The **MEN** contestants will play from the **BLUE** tee markers, and the **WOMEN** contestants will play from the **RED** tee markers. There will be a play-off, if necessary, to determine first place (within each flight) immediately following the conclusion of play.

FLIGHTS: Flights were created using **March 15th** indexes:

PRESIDENT FLIGHT: Team Course Handicap range **(10 and under)**

DIRECTOR FLIGHT: Team Course Handicap range **(11 - 18)**

SECRETARY FLIGHT: Team Course Handicap range **(19 and up)**

RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA hard card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition. The "One Ball Rule" is not in effect.

FIRST TEE TIME: 8:00 AM off tees 1 & 10. Players should be at their assigned tee 10 minutes prior to their tee time.

GOLF CARTS: Golf carts are optional at the player's expense. Cart rental is **\$20** per person. A maximum of two carts per group is permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUND: The NCGA does not arrange practice rounds. Contact the Carmel Valley Ranch Pro Shop at (831) 626-2510 and identify yourself as a participant in this event. Practice rounds, including a cart and range balls, will be offered for \$80 based on availability and discretion of the Pro Shop.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason **MUST** notify the NCGA Championships and Events Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a **NO SHOW** and the player will receive a **ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION.** A player who only contacts the course and **NOT** the NCGA will incur the suspension.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

DRESS CODE: Refer to NCGA rules card <http://www.ncga.org/rules-competitions/rules-regulations-policies/>.

PRO SHOP & RANGE: Open at 6:30 AM.

FOOD SERVICE: Opens at 6:30 AM. To avoid losing position and receiving a penalty for slow play, we recommend all players order ready-made food at the grill or restaurant during their stipulated rounds. **No outside food and beverage is permitted.**
