

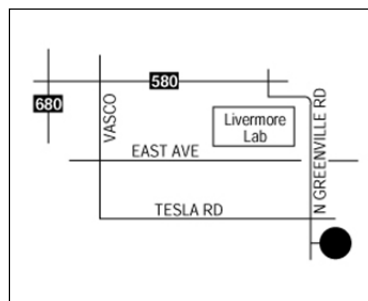

PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read carefully.

FORMAT: 36 holes foursome stroke play (Rule 29), 18 holes per day. Partners will play one ball – during the stipulated round the partners shall play alternately from the teeing grounds and alternately during the play of each hole. Before each round partners need to decide which one will play from the even tees and which one will play from the odd numbered tees. Penalty strokes do not affect the order of play. **ROUND 1: The Chardonnay course will be played as holes 1-9 and Zinfandel will be 10-18. ROUND 2: The Chardonnay course will be 1-9. Merlot course will be played as holes 10-18.**

NOTE: Teams will be re-paired by score for the second round. First starting time Sunday morning will be 7:00 am.

PAIRINGS PARTY: At the end of Saturday's round (1st Round) there will be a Pairings Party/BBO for all teams from 4:00pm – 8:00pm. Several games will be offered with donated prizes awarded. During this event, the pairings for Sunday's round will also be announced. Costs for the party were covered with your team's entry fee.

PLAY-OFF: The format for the Championship is foursome stroke play. Ties for first place only in each flight will be broken by a playoff. If a playoff cannot be conducted (decision of the Committee and golf course), the USGA suggested method of matching cards will be used.

HANDICAPS: 50% of the combined course handicaps will be used. Men in the President Flight will play the **BLUE** yardage. Men in the Director and Secretary Flights will play from the **WHITE** yardage; all women will play from the **GOLD** yardage.

FLIGHTS: There will be three flights based on the Teams Combined Course Handicap Index. **PLEASE NOTE THAT FLIGHTS WERE BUILT USING THE JUNE 15, 2013 INDEX, BUT PLAY WILL BE TO THE JULY 1, 2013 INDEX.**

AWARDS: Each flight: Champion – Gold, Runner-Up – Silver, Third Place – Bronze. Duplicate medals awarded for third place ties.



RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

STARTING TIMES / LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and all players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. See "Time of Starting" in the enclosed NCGA rules card.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Golf carts are optional at the player's expense. A maximum of three carts per group are permitted. Cart rental is \$17.00 per rider. Pull carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

NOTE: Carts must be driven by a player with a valid driver's license.

DRESS CODE: See NCGA rules card.

FOOTWEAR: Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Call the Poppy Ridge Pro Shop at the number listed above, and identify yourself as a contestant in this event.

PRO SHOP & RANGE: Opens at 6:00 AM.

FOOD SERVICE: Snack Bar and Restaurant will be open at 6:00 a.m. Cash and credit cards are accepted. No club reciprocals will be accepted.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: See enclosed NCGA rules card. Players who have entered into a NCGA event and wish to **withdraw for any reason MUST notify the NCGA Championships & Events Department at (831) 625-4653. You may call during regular business hours or between 5:00 PM and 8:00 AM and leave a message. Failure to notify the NCGA will cause the player to be listed as a NO SHOW resulting in a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FOR ALL NCGA EVENTS.** A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.
