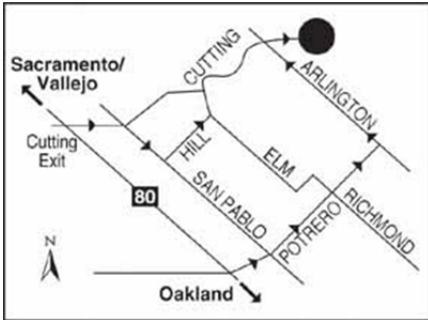


CONTESTANT INFORMATION SHEET

Please read the following information carefully! The 2012-2015 USGA Rules of Golf as supplemented by the USGA Girls Junior Amateur Championship application, the USGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for 2013 Championships and the Local Rules published by the Committee in the Notice to Players will govern all play.

Format: The competition will consist of one 18-hole round, gross score, stroke play. Play will be from the **WHITE** tees. Yardages can be found on the accompanying yardage sheet. Ties for qualifying/alternate positions will be broken by a playoff commencing immediately following completion of the stipulated round. The top **7** individuals will advance to the Championship to be held at Sycamore Hills Golf Club in Fort Wayne, Indiana, July 22-27, 2013.

One Ball Rule: The optional condition as prescribed in Appendix I shall be in effect.

Practice Rounds: Practice rounds are available for contestants at \$40, rounds will not be available Sunday June 30. **DO NOT CALL THE PRO SHOP.** Contestants should **email** the Head Professional, Thomas Fong, at tfong@miravista.org, to reserve a tee time.

Starting Times: All players are expected to report to the starter "ready to play" prior to their scheduled starting time to receive information on local rules, hole locations etc. "Ready to Play" means on the assigned tee, with a golf ball and golf club in hand. Starters will not "call" players to the tee. Contestants are solely responsible for knowing their starting time and tee assignment.

1ST Tee Time: **9:00 AM** off tees 1&10.

Dress Code: Players and caddies must be properly attired on the course and the club premises. Blue jeans, designer jeans, T-shirts, cutoffs and tank, halter or tube tops are prohibited. Men's shirts must be collared. Shorts must reach to mid-thigh. Dress code is the same for spectators.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome throughout the competition. They must remain at least 25 yards from any competitor and may not provide advice during the play of either round. Violation of this prohibition could result in the disqualification of the player. **SPECTATORS MUST WALK AT ALL TIMES, NO EXCEPTIONS. PLEASE NOTE THAT MIRA VISTA CAN BE A VERY DIFFICULT WALKING COURSE. AS USGA POLICY DICTATES THIS EVENT, DISABLED SPECTATOR CARTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.**

Footwear: **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.** Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

Automotive Transportation: The use of automotive transportation is prohibited for both players and caddies. Players AND caddies must walk. Push/pull carts are permitted.

Caddies: Players are reminded that a competitor's parent, stepparent or guardian may *not* caddie for her. Siblings may caddie for a competitor. Mira Vista Country Club does not have caddies available for hire.

Distance Measuring Devices: Distance measuring devices, including GPS based systems and laser rangefinders are **not allowed.** The penalty for use is disqualification.

Food Service: Lunch will **NOT** be provided for contestants. The snack bar, located by the 9th green, will be open from 9am-3pm. Cash, credit card, or reciprocal club charges are accepted.

Clubhouse, Pro Shop: The clubhouse and pro shop will open at 7am.

Driving Range: The driving range will open at 7:30 am. A limited number of stalls are available for contestants. Please be respectful of fellow competitors and limit practice time. Please note that limited flight balls are used on the Mira Vista driving range.
