ACTS CADDIE MAY PERFORM WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION RULE 10.3b (9)	
(i)	Carry, transport and handle clubs or equipment.
(ii)	Search for player's ball.
(iii)	Give information, advice or other help before stroke.
(iv)	Smooth bunkers or other actions to care for the course.
(v)	Remove sand or soil or repair damage on putting green.
(vi)	Remove or attend flagstick.
(vii)	Mark, lift and replace player's ball on putting green.
(viii)	Clean player's ball.
(ix)	Remove loose impediments and movable obstructions.
RULE 5.7a STOPPING PLAY – WHEN PERMITTED	
(i)	Committee has suspended play.
(ii)	Stopping Play by Agreement in Match Play (No Delay to Competition)
(iii)	Lightning
