The top 112 players on the points list as of October 16th will receive an invitation to participate in the Weekend Net Tour Playoff on Saturday November 16 at Silverado Resort. The top 40 players on the Player of the Year list after the playoff event will receive an invitation to the Tour Championship in December.

The top 4 players on the points list after the playoff event will receive a PAID entry into the Tour Championship.

For each 2019 NCGA Weekend Net Tour event, a “point level” designation will be given based on the field size as shown in the table. Players with a high finish will receive placement points for the event based on field size. Players who do not receive placement points will receive a participation bonus for finishing the event. A “no-show,” “no-card,” or “disqualification” will result in a player receiving no points for the event.

Ties: players/sides who tie for a position will split points, **EXCEPT** 1st place, which will be tie-broken.

Partner events: For partner events, partners will split the points based on finishing position.

NCGA (Net) Championships: Any Weekend Net Tour player who competes in an NCGA Net Championship (Public Links Net, Senior Net, Women’s Net, Associate Club Four-Ball Net, Four-Ball Net, Senior Four-Ball Net, Associate Club Net Amateur, and/or Net Amateur) will receive points using this chart based on his/her finish in the championship. Players must have competed in a WNT event prior to playing the championship in order to receive points. For partner events both players must have competed in a WNT event in order to split points.
