New to 2020, senior players (55-64) and super senior players (65 and above) will have separate points divisions. The top 20 players from each of the Senior and Super Senior divisions points lists will qualify for the Senior Series Championship at (TBD) on (TBD).

Players who begin their season at age 64 and turn 65 during the season will remain in the senior division for the remainder of the season. (new)

The top 2 players on the points list from each division at the end of the regular season will receive a PAID entry into the Senior Series Championship.

For each 2020 Senior Series event, a “point level” designation will be given based on the field size of the division as shown in the table. Players will receive placement points for their finish. A “no-show,” “no-card,” or “disqualification” will result in a player receiving no points for the event.

Ties: players/sides who tie for a position will split points, **EXCEPT** 1st place, which will be tie-broken.

Partner events: For partner events, partners will split the points based on finishing position.

NCGA Senior Net Championships: Any Senior Series player who qualifies for either the NCGA Senior Net Championship (June 1-2) or the NCGA Senior Four-Ball Net Championship (September 14-15) will receive 100 points to the Senior Series Player of the Year race for qualifying. In order to receive these points, the player must have competed in a Senior Series event prior to the first round of the championship he/she has qualified for. (new)
